## **Format and Rules**

1. All Bowlers will bowl 4 games of qualifying.
2. 1:4 entries from each squad will advance to the finals
3. Bowlers will use their highest verifiable average from the 2020-2021 bowling season (min 21 games), if no average exists, bowlers may use their highest verifiable average from the 2019-2020 or 2018-2019 season whichever is higher (min 21 games). All others will use 220.
4. Re-Entries are allowed if space permits. Re-entries will occur on a first come, first served basis.
5. If there is a tie for the last qualifying spot, both players will advance
6. The first round of the finals, everyone will bowl 2 games, pinfall will NOT carry over from the qualifying scores. The top 8 scores after 2 games will advance to the next round
7. If there is a tie for the 8<sup>th</sup> place, a one ball sudden death roll off will take place with the bowler who had the higher qualifying score after 4 games will start the sudden death round. This will continue until the tie is broken.
8. The top 8 will then bowl eliminator style format 1 game, (4 bowlers advance) The 4 bowlers that advance will then bowl 1 game with the highest score determining the winner.
9. Any other ties in the top 8 the prize money will be split between the two spots.
10. USBC Youth bowlers will be allowed to participate provided they sign the rule 400 waiver. All monies won by any youth will be deposited into their USBC SMART Account.
11. Bowlers are asked to arrive at least 30 minutes prior to squad time. Any bowler arriving late may be allowed to bowl but must take a zero for every frame that is missed provided there is space available
12. Prize Money returned 100%
13. All USBC Rules are in effect. Any rule that is not listed here will fall under USBC guidelines.
14. The tournament director has the final ruling on all disputes, tournament format, and prize fund.
15. Per CDC Guidelines, individuals who are vaccinated are not required to wear a face mask.
16. Lanes will be oiled before the 11AM Squad ONLY.
