### NO-TAP HANDICAP TEAM TOURNAMENT RULES:

- 1.All USBC rules not specifically listed here will be in effect.
- 2. No-Tap means Nine (9) pins down on your first delivery counts as a strike.
- 3. Regular Strikes count for strikes as usual.
- 4. All other scoring is normal.
- 5. Buy a strike once a game for \$1 except in 10th frame.
- 6. AVERAGES: All bowlers will use their highest verifiable average from the 2023-
- 2024 season (min 21 games), if current average is 10 pins higher than 2023-2024 average, he or she must use their current average (min 21 games). Anyone without a 2023-2024 average must use their highest current verifiable average (min 21 games). It is each bowlers responsibility to verify his/her average whether submitted by the bowler or another person.
- 7. Handicap will be based on 100% of the difference of the bowlers average and 225.
- 8. Any bowler that does not have the specified averages above in Rule 6 will use the highest most recent average in any season on bowl.com (if available).
- 8a. Any Male without a verifiable average will get an average of 180. Any Female will get a 150 average.
- 9. Teams may enter as many times as they wish. A team can cash more than once but must switch at least 2 bowlers.
- 10. RE-RATING: All entrants required to be familiar with USBC re-rating requirement.
- 11. The tournament has the right to reject or re-rate any entry without penalty prior to the time of actual participation. Entry will be returned if entrants do not wish to participate after being notified of re-rating.
- 12. Any bowler who has re-rated by any tournament or association must inform the tournament committee of the re-rating. Any bowler who has been disqualified in any tournament (verifiable or certified), must report this before bowling and is subject to re-rate or denial of entry based on his/her report.
- 13. Any bowler who reports a lower average than required will cause his/her team to forfeit all tournament fees and winnings.
- 14. A bowler arriving late will be allowed to bowl but his/her score will start with the frame in which he/she is ready to bowl.
- 15. All claims for errors in scoring must be submitted in writing to the tournament committee within 24 hours after the score is bowled.
- 16. All guarantees listed on the front of the tournament entry blank will be paid as well as one (1) prize for every 6 entries. Lanes will be assigned by the tournament management.
- 17. Entries close February 7th at 6:30 pm.
- 18. In the event of a major pinsetter breakdown, the tournament management reserves the right to move bowlers to other lanes.
- 19. Unmarried high school students under 18 years of age must furnish a signed parental consent form. Failure to do so disqualifies bowlers scores as well as any prizes the team might have won.
- 20. Premature termination of the tournament brought about by war, national emergency, or emergency causes relating to thereto or therefrom: fire strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties, or other causes beyond the control of Lucky Strike Lanes shall cause the foregoing prize schedules to be pro-rated in accordance with the number of entrants who have bowled in the tournament up to the time of the termination.
